

1994 H.A.R.D. Corps #17 – “Send in the Armorines”

January – The Armorines are assigned to capture H.A.R.D. Corps members in order to learn where they get their powers. They trick the H.A.R.D. Corps team into a trap and defeat them. Gunny recognizes Virgil and calls off the mission.

H.A.R.D. Corps #18 – “Ghosts”

January – The H.A.R.D. Corps are attacked again by the Armorines, but thanks to the cool heads of Lewis and Gunslinger they're able to sort out who is who and come to the realization that both of their operations are funded by Senator Ackerman.

January – In Ladakh, Tibet Chan trains in archery and philosophy.

(Conjecture: “Weeks later.”)(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #11)

Clay McHenry, a cop in New York City, is blinded and his partner James Simpson is crippled after being involved in an illegal transaction.

(Geomancer #1)(Geomancer #2)

Ivar, the Timewalker, struggles to program a VCR.

(Conjecture: Sometime in 1994.)(Timewalker #3)

January 18 – Livewire sets up a date with Seth to go see a movie on February 1st.

(Secret Weapons #7)

Eternal Warrior #21 – “On the Shoulders of Giants”

January – Gilad travels to Nevada to visit Dr. Steiner, a scientist who worked on the hydrogen bomb. Gilad is under the impression that Steiner had requested his presence, but he was actually called by Al Sharpsteen, an associate of Steiner's. Sharpsteen fears that Steiner plans to launch nuclear weapons and start World War III. Gilad stops Steiner.

January 20 – Senator Okubo of Japan is threatened by the Yakuza with the kidnapping of his daughter, Michiko.

(Conjecture: Late January.)(Ninjak #3)

Archer & Armstrong #21 – “Ladakh Attack”

January 25 – A messenger from Ladakh arrives in Los Angeles and informs Archer that Master Darque attacked their temple and killed many monks. Archer vows to put an end to Darque and travels to Louisiana to confront Darque.

January 26 - Archer meets up with Shadowman and the two attack Darque. Archer is captured.

January 26 – Senator Okubo fakes the kidnapping of his daughter Michiko.

(Ninjak #3)

Archer & Armstrong #22 – “The Darque at the Top of the Stairs”

January 26 – Armstrong flies to New Orleans to help Archer escape from Master Darque.

Ninjak #3 – “The 7th Dragon”

January 26 – Colin King attends a charity ball at Buckingham Palace. There he is met by Neville Alcott who convinces King to join his organization. The Seventh Dragon attacks a group of Yakuza searching for Michiko.

January 27 – Ninjak arrives in Japan, and after rescuing Senator Okubo from a group of Yakuza he confronts him on the whereabouts of Michiko.

Harbinger #28 – “Heal Thyself”

January 27 – Butch undergoes psychiatric evaluation which results in him attacking his therapist.

January 27 – With the help of Sandria, Armstrong frees Archer from Master Darque.

(Archer & Armstrong #22)

Shadowman #0 – “Shadowmen”

January 27 – Armstrong tells Jack Boniface the origin of the first Shadowman, Maxim St. James. Nettie tells Jack that his powers are different than St. James’ because Darque had Lydia infected Jack with an alien virus.

(Conjecture: Date is placed to coincide with Armstrong’s visit to New Orleans.)

Shadowman #24 – “H.A.T.E.”

January 27 – Shadowman breaks up a hate crime.

(Editor’s Note: Jack is finishing his conversation with Armstrong at the beginning of this issue. That is where the date is derived.)

January 28 – Jack goes on the radio to promote his upcoming album, but instead of talking about the album the discussion is about Leland Paige, the new Senator whose group H.A.T.E. promotes the hatred of other races and sexual orientations.

January 28 – Ninjak discovers where Michiko is being hidden.

(Ninjak #3)

Ninjak #4 – “The 7th Dragon, Part 2 – Dragonslayer”

January 28 – With the help of Goro Sanada, revealed to be the Seventh Dragon, Ninjak rescues Michiko from Toshihiro Matsuda, a Yakuza Oyabun.

January 29 – Ninjak leaves Japan.

January 29 – Shadowman beats up Leland Paige.

(Shadowman #24)

January 30 – Shadowman approaches Nettie about becoming more powerful in hopes of breaking Darque’s curse.

(Shadowman #24)

Ninjak #5 – “Full Metal Jacket”

January 30 – Webnet attempts to infect Orb Industries computers with a virus. Ninjak arrives in New York to stop them.

(Editor’s Note: The date of March 7th doesn’t work because Aric refers to his armor as being Shanhara.)

Ninjak #6 – “Full Metal Jacket, Part 2”

January 30 – With the help of Aric, Ninjak is able to put a stop to Webnet’s plans. Ninjak learns that Dr. Silk is still alive.

January 31 – The Harbinger Foundation begins plans to reacquire Stronghold and Livewire.

(Harbinger #28)

January 31 – Solar stops a group of fake prospectors seeding treasure on sunken ships in San Francisco.

(Solar, Man of the Atom #32)

Secret Weapons #6 – “The Horror Below, Part 1”

February 1 – Tom Morgan is aided in a murder investigation by Geoff McHenry. McHenry recruits Stronghold and Livewire. The four go into the sewer system and discover a large colony of Spider Aliens.

(Editor’s Note: The Date of November 1st does not work in conjunction with X-O Manowar #26 and Harbinger #28. Based on Harbinger #28, Ninjak #5, and to keep the spirit of the original date, I’ve placed this issue on February 1st.)

February 1 – Turok visits Aric at his New York residence. The two of them discover a tunnel which has been used by Spider Aliens. They explore the tunnel and find a colony of Spider Aliens.

(X-O Manowar #27)

Secret Weapons #7 – “The Horror Below, Part 2”

February 1 – Gilad, Aric and Turok join in the fight against the Spider Aliens. Geoff discovers that the catacombs holding this colony of Spider Aliens stretches for hundreds of miles.

X-O Manowar #27 – “The Hunt”

Aric and Turok come to the assistance of Stronghold, Livewire, Geoff, Gilad and Morgan who are also fighting the Spider Aliens. Aric fights a Spider Alien was a priest from the late 1600’s. Aric defeats him. Aric and Turok stay in the catacombs to continue the hunt.

February 1 – Gilad, Livewire, Stronghold, Geoff and Morgan escape the Spider Alien catacombs.

(Secret Weapons #8)

Solar, Man of the Atom #32 – “Parent’s Night”

February 1 – Phil Seleski convinces his father not to cut the funding on his Berkeley project. Geoff calls Solar to let him know about the Spider Aliens colony under New York.

X-O Manowar #28 – “Carnage!”

February 1 – Randy and Paul join Aric and Turok in their fight against the Spider Aliens. The Spider Aliens are able to destroy Shanbara, the XO armor, after they’ve slowly poisoned it.

X-O Manowar #29 – “Desolation”

February 1 – After the XO armor is destroyed Paul and Turok rescue Aric from the Spider Alien queen. Paul becomes badly injured in the fight. Aric, Turok, Randy and Paul escape the catacombs. Paul is rushed to the hospital. Solar arrives to aide in the fight against the Spider Aliens but Aric tells him he’s too late.

February 2 – Aric and Randy fight over the loss of Shanbara and then make love. Paul’s legs are amputated.

(X-O Manowar #29)

X-O Manowar #30 – “Seeds of Hope”

February 2 – Solar explores the caverns where the Spider Aliens were hiding. Paul’s blood is infected with Spider Alien poison. Solar goes to Saturn and finds a seed on the XO Manowar class armor he fought against in 1991.

Bloodshot #15 – “The Hunter: The Hunted”

February 4 – Cinder and Glyder attack Bloodshot hoping that killing him will get them back in good graces with Dr. Silk. Bloodshot defeats them.

Secret Weapons #8 – “The Price”

February 5 – The Harbinger Foundation, at the request of Gilad, reacquires Stronghold and Livewire.

(Editor’s Note: Neville’s comments about Gilad having trouble getting out of Saudi Arabia make little sense since that took place in October.)

February 5 – Bloodshot, Gilad and Geoff begin searching for the Weaponeer’s vault.

(Bloodshot #15)

February 5 – Solar gives Aric the XO Manowar armor seed he found. In order for the seed to become armor it needs to bond with a living being.

(Conjecture: “Several days later.”)(X-O Manowar #30)

February 5 – Stronghold and Livewire are brought to the Harbinger Foundation facility at Bolivar, Missouri.

(Harbinger #29)

February 6 – Paul bonds with the XO Manowar armor seed and dies.

(X-O Manowar #30)

February 7 – Randy goes to Canada for Paul’s funeral.

(X-O Manowar #30)

X-O Manowar #31 – “Subterfuge, Part 1 – Old Haunts”

February 8 – Aric tries out his new armor, Pol-Bekhara. An employee of Orb Industries dies trying to gain access to a vault at one of Orb Industries facilities. Randy visits with old friends in Vancouver.

February 9 – Aric investigates the death of one of his employees. He runs into Krollos, a Harbinger who also has advanced weaponry. Krollos tries to gain access to the vault.

X-O Manowar #32 – “Subterfuge, Part 2 – Blinded”

February 9 – Aric defeats Krollos. Inside the vault is a Spider Alien vessel. Randy attends Paul’s funeral. David, another compatriot of Randy’s dies under mysterious circumstances.

Shadowman #25 – “A Nightmare on Bourbon Street”

February – Shadowman fights and defeats a man who can kill in his dreams.

Secret Weapons #9 – “Search for the Vault”

February – Gilad, Bloodshot and Geoff travel the globe searching for the Weaponeer’s vault. They discover it in a volcano in the Philippines. Webnet follows them.

Secret Weapons #10 – “Search and Destroy”

February – Gilad, Bloodshot and Geoff destroy the Weaponeer’s vault causing the volcano to erupt. They recover three suits that Neville will use in Project: Secret Weapons. Colin King is revealed to be the Weaponeer.

Shadowman #26 – “Glitter Night”

February 11 – Jack tries to track down Papa Napoleon, a drug dealer in New Orleans, whose identity is unknown. Darryl Whittaker, who Jack was hoping would give him information on Napoleon, is killed by Ishmael, an assassin who can use everyday objects to kill

February 12 – Jack saves a woman named Marcia from some muggers.

Harbinger #29 – “Truth and Consequences”

February 12 - Livewire asks Faith for help in locating Stronghold. She hasn’t seen him since she was brought to Bolivar.

February 14 – B-Squad at the Harbinger Foundation facility in Bolivar, mops the floor with toothpaste. St. Paul, Minnesota gets a foot of snow.

February 15 – Livewire attempts to escape from the Harbinger Foundation. She is quickly captured. The B-Squad search for her and Stronghold that night and discover that their minds have been tampered with.

February 15 – Papa Napoleon hires Ishmael to kill Shadowman. The two fight. Ishmael stabs Jack in the heart with an iron pole and leaves him for dead.

(Shadowman #26)

Shadowman #27 – “The Morning After”

February 16 – Jack goes to Marcia’s house and she helps him pull the pipe out of his chest. He passes out and she brings him to the hospital. Ishmael is given a second chance by Papa Napoleon to kill Shadowman. He finds out what hospital Jack’s in and attempts to kill him. Jack fights him off, but reveals himself to the police in the process.

February 17 – Papa Napoleon tries to kill Ishmael but fails. Ishmael promises to kill Shadowman.

Shadowman #28 – “Something Coming”

February 17 – Jack is discharged from the hospital.

February 18 – Jack goes to Marcia’s to retrieve his mask and they make love. After, Jack confronts Master Darque, but is unable to fight him.

The USS Benchley, a nuclear submarine, sinks. All hands are lost.

(Armorines #3)

February - Paulie, a valley boy from Southern California orders a Mercedes Benz.

(Conjecture: Paulie says he did it “months ago.”)(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #11)

Bloodshot #16 – “Divided We Fall”

February – Bloodshot is shot in the head while protecting an ambassador who is seeking peace accords in his war-torn nation.

Bloodshot #17 – “Coma”

February – After getting shot in the head Bloodshot is in a coma. Member of the H.A.R.D. Corps steal him from a Swiss medical facility hoping to reverse the coma’s effects. The nanites in Bloodshot’s blood successfully reverse the coma.

February – The Harbinger Foundation accepts the commercial aerospace contract bid of Littman-Martan Aerospace. Mr. Martan takes control of the project. Accidents and delays plague the project.

(Conjecture: Elliot Littman says this happened “a few weeks ago.”)(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #9)

Eternal Warrior #22 – “A Little Knowledge...”

February – Gilad and Geoff locate and destroy a book that had copies of necromantic spells. Master Darque also wanted the book but is pleased with its destruction.

February – Captain Red and his crew arrive from the Lost Land after the events in Unity. They lie low learning about the new time they are in.

(Conjecture: Captain Red says they’ve been in this time period “for weeks.”)(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #13)

Solar, Man of the Atom #33 – “Genocide, Part 1”

February – The Destroyer continues his search for the Spider Aliens amongst the stars.

Solar, Man of the Atom #34 – “Genocide, Part 2”

February – The Destroyer attempts to liberate a group of humans from a Spider Alien colony, but fails.

February – The Destroyer destroys the Spider Alien colony after the group of humans he tried to free die. The Destroyer continues his search for the Spider Aliens.

(Solar, Man of the Atom #35)

Archer & Armstrong #23 – “Bad Karma”

March – After rescuing Ethan Rosen, Archer gets involved in a mob war.

Archer & Armstrong #24 – “Bad Karma, Part 2”

March – Archer and Armstrong save Ethan Rosen from a mob hit.

March - Geoff McHenry writes a letter to Neville Alcott revealing that Bloodshot survived the Rising Spirit experiments because he has a Harbinger ability.

(Secrets of the Valiant Universe #1 – Bloodshot)

Armorines #1 – “Fathoms Below, Part 1 – White Death”

March – The Armorines are sent to detonate the USS Benchley, a submarine that sank and has classified information in it. The Armorines encounter massive great white sharks during the mission.

Armorines #2 – “Fathoms Below, Part 2 – Frenzy”

March – The Armorines fight off the great white sharks. Siroit is separated from the rest of the group.

Armorines #3 – “Fathoms Below, Part 3 – Enemy Action”

March – Siroit is abducted by Spider Aliens. He learns that they were behind the sinking of the USS Benchley, that they are responsible for the mutated great white sharks, and that they are planning a “gathering.” The rest of the Armorines rescue Siroit and the Spider Aliens vessels is destroyed.

March – Webnet gains access to the Harbinger Foundation computer files.

(Secrets of the Valiant Universe #1 – Harbinger)

The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #8 – “Food for Thought”

March – Hwen loses control of his form and starts to fade away. He turns to Sandria Darque for help. She helps him regain his form.

March – Stuart, a repair tech at Omen Enterprises, confronts Director Sigmund Heydrich, saying he knows Heydrich was responsible for the death of Superstar. Heydrich kills Stuart.

(Secrets of the Valiant Universe #1 – The H.A.R.D. Corps)

March 13 – Joe Vantago, a mobster, shoots a group of carnies for not paying protection money. Lenny Branuzzi, a clown, survives. Bloodshot makes a deal with Det, a young drug pusher, for information.

(Bloodshot #19)

March 14 – Lenny Branuzzi is visited in the hospital by some of his carnival friends.

(Conjecture: Assumes it's the next day.)(Bloodshot #19)

March – Neville Alcott has the members of Project: Secret Weapons begin training.

(Secret Weapons #11)

Harbinger #30 – “Bad Omen, Part 1”

March – Members of the H.A.R.D. Corps sneak into the Harbinger Foundation facility in Bolivar, Missouri. Their mission is to locate Toyo Harada, who is in a coma, scan his brainwaves and kill him. They encounter the B-Squad and quickly fight them off. They find Harada and successfully scan his brainwaves.

H.A.R.D. Corps #19 – “Bad Omen, Part 2 – Hard Decisions”

March – Before the H.A.R.D. Corps team can kill Harada they are attacked by the B-Squad again. The H.A.R.D. Corps escape with a copy of Harada’s brainwaves. Harada wakes up from his coma.

Harbinger #31 – “Bad Omen, Part 3 – Last Rites”

March – Harada regains control of his company after waking up from his coma. Takashi Kuramoto kills himself for running the Harbinger Foundation so poorly in Harada’s absence. Harada launches an attack on Omen Enterprises in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

H.A.R.D. Corps #20 – “Bad Omen, Part 4 – H.A.R.D. Retribution”

March – The H.A.R.D. Corps successfully fend off the Harbinger attack despite Harada sending Livewire to the battle. Heydrich still possesses the brainwave patterns of Harada.

March – Shadowman attacks Master Darque and learns that Darque can’t kill him.

(Secrets of the Valiant Universe #1 – Shadowman)

March 28 – Lenny Branuzzi trains to become the vigilante Uzzi the Clown.

(Bloodshot #19)

March – Gilad practices his ability to throw a spear blind folded in Washington Square Park.

(Eternal Warrior #23)

Bloodshot #19 – “Tears of a Clown”

March 31 – Lenny Branuzzi visits the graves of his fellow Carnies.

(Conjecture: “Several days later.”)

April 1 – Uzzi the Clown kills Vantago for killing his friends. He then decides to start cleaning up the streets. He targets Det, a young drug pusher. Bloodshot stops Uzzi from killing Det. Uzzi falls off a bridge.

The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #9 – “Dream Lover”

April – Hwen and Carmen investigate Littman-Martan Aerospace after Elliot Littman fears that his partner is possessed. Hwen discovers Martan’s dead body. The Otherman has been impersonating Martan and sabotaging Littman-Martan Aerospace projects. The Otherman attempts to seduce Carmen by pretending to be Hwen. Hwen bursts in to stop him.

The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #10 – “Surrogate Lover”

April – Hwen’s mother arrives while he’s fighting Otherman and he reveals to her he’s a ghost. Hwen defeats Otherman.

Miss Lucy makes an appointment to see Toyo Harada in October.

(H.A.R.D. Corps #30)

Bloodshot Yearbook #1 – “Blood and Roses”

April – While investigating the mob in New York for the DEA, Bloodshot is caught in an explosion. He’s found by Anna Trebecchi, the wife of a mobster, and nursed back to health. Bloodshot falls for her and saves her husband from being killed by other mobsters.

April – Gilad, visiting London, reminisces about Buck McHenry.

(Eternal Warrior #24)

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #13 – “Captain Red, Part 1 – Killing Time”

April – Turok, Regan and Andy go to Cape Cynthia. Captain Red and his crew are also there.

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #14 – “Captain Red, Part 2 – Time to Born”

April – Captain Red and his crew break into the Port Cynthia College Library to steal cartographic maps. Andy tries to stop him and is injured by Captain Red. After Captain Red and his crew leave, Turok begins tracking them in the sewers.

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #15 – “Captain Red, Part 3 – Out of Time”

April – Captain Red and his crew find Captain Red’s buried treasure. Turok tracks the group and he and Captain Red fight. Turok sends Captain Red and his crew through a portal that leads them back to the Lost Land.

Bloodshot #18 – “Download”

April – Bloodshot stops Bhutu Hassan, a Palestinian who has gained access to a nuclear weapon.

April – Neville Alcott, Jillian Alcott and Charles Sinclair go over the roster of Project: Secret Weapons.
(Secrets of the Valiant Universe #1 – Secret Weapons)

Secret Weapons #11 – “Project: Secret Weapons”

April – The new Secret Weapons team has a training exercise with Bloodshot. After the exercise Neville Alcott informs them that they are to go on their first mission investigating an island under the control of Webnet.

Secret Weapons #12 – “Webnet Island”

April – The Secret Weapons team is successful in stopping Webnet’s plans, but not without a cost. Richard Grant, Para-Man, dies. Charles Sinclair takes his place on the team.

April – Gilad and Rosalie decide to stop seeing each other.

(Conjecture: Gilad says the relationship has “been over for months.”)(Eternal Warrior #33)

Jack Boniface records a song called *She Is the Light*.

(Conjecture: Sometime in 1994.)(Shadowman #5)

Two U.N. ambassadors are assassinated by Ishak Hadji, also known as Djinn. Hadji uses a smart gun to pull off the assassinations.

(Ninjak #7)

Randy asks a specialist at Orb Industries to analyze the autopsy report for her friend David.

(X-O Manowar #33)

Turok Dinosaur Hunter Yearbook #1 – “Mon-Ark Lives”

May – Omen Enterprises discovers Mon-Ark’s Bionisaur implants. They attach the implants to a dead Olympic athlete and Mon-Ark is reborn. Turok, with the help of Regan, stops Mon-Ark. Omen Enterprises steals Mon-Ark’s unconscious body.

May – Armstrong tells a psychiatrist about his adventures in the Crusades.

(Archer & Armstrong #25)

May – Armstrong continues to tell a psychiatrist about himself and his brother during the Crusades.

(Eternal Warrior #25)

May 7 – Mademoiselle Noir is captured by agents working for Neville Alcott. They interview Noir but she uses her pheromones against them and escapes.

(Ninjak #8)

H.A.R.D. Corps #21 – “Midnight’s Run”

May – Earl Simkus, on the run from the Harbinger Foundation, locates members of the H.A.R.D. Corps and demands that they help him. The H.A.R.D. Corps team fights a group of Star Soldiers.

H.A.R.D. Corps #22 – “Chokehold”

May – The H.A.R.D. Corps team successfully fights off the Harbinger Star Soldiers.

Ninjak #7 – “Fire and Forget”

May – After the assassination of Spiro Duranna, a U.N. negotiator, Ninjak tracks down and kills the assassin, Ishak Hadji.

May - Arturo Vasquez, a US citizen and former Cuban refugee, retires and moves to Mexico. He begins designing new weapons based on Spider Alien technology.

(Armorines #9)

Solar, Man of the Atom #36 – “Last Tango in Muskogee”

May – Dr. Eclipse frees himself from the silver mine Dr. Mirage trapped him in. He finds Ravenus in Muskogee, and Ravenus leads him to John Veerhusen’s house. Eclipse and Mirage use John as bait to lure Solar into a battle.

Solar, Man of the Atom #37 – “Where Madness Dwells”

May – Solar fights Dr. Eclipse and Ravenus. Solar traps Ravenus in unreality and Dr. Eclipse escapes. John Veerhusen tells Solar that they can no longer be friends.

Harbinger #32 – “Incandescent Expectations”

May – Gilad Abrams visits the Harbinger Foundation facility in Bolivar, Missouri to speak with Harada. Abrams learns that Livewire and Stronghold were both brainwashed. The B-Squad begin a cross-country trip.

Samantha McHenry leaves her husband Clay.

(Geomancer #2)

May – The Harbinger Foundation’s primary manufacturing facility is attacked.

(Harbinger Files #2)

June 12 – Turok climbs a rock in a canyon in Utah and begins meditating.

(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #10)

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #10 – “The Last of the Kiowa”

June 13 – Chun Lee Fat, a trader in rare animal parts, destroys Bile’s Dude Ranch for some white buffalo horn. Turok aides Bile in taking revenge on Chun Lee Fat’s men.

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #11 – “The Rag & Bone Man”

June 13 – Turok begins travelling to Los Angeles to find Chun Lee Fat and his dinosaur.

June 14 – Turok meets Lyle Jakes, a Blackfoot, who helps him get connections to the underground rare animal market.

Armorines #4 – “Debriefing”

June – The Spider Aliens launch their ships from their hiding places all over the world. The Armorines and the H.A.R.D. Corps agree to work together to stop them in outer space.

June 20 – Turok gets into a fight with gang members working for Chun Lee Fat. They lead him to Fat’s base of operations. Inside Turok is confronted by a Bionisaur.

(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #11)

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #12 – “Return of the Dragon”

June 20 – Turok kills the Bionisaur and all of Chun Lee Fat’s henchmen. After he kills Chun Lee Fat he is attacked by another Bionisaur, the mate of the first one, and he kills it.

Harbinger #33 – “Total Eclipse”

June 20 – The Harbinger B-Squad encounters Doctor Eclipse in Ohio. Faith blows him up and then decides to leave the team to learn about her past. The rest of the group soon find out that Doctor Eclipse wasn’t defeated as they square off with him again.

The Chaos Effect Alpha – “Chaos Rules”

June 21 – Having arrived from some distant time, Ivar the Timewalker, ends up in Ladakh, Tibet. With him comes a tremendous amount of necromantic energy from a great war. The energy spreads around the entire globe empowering those with necromantic energy, and making all electronics useless. A man at the temple in Ladakh, known simply as the Visitor, peers into Ivar’s mind.

(Editor’s Note: Tibetan time.)

June 20 – After the sudden flow of necromantic energy electronic devices stop working. Planes fall out of the sky around Heathrow Airport. One plane is carrying Jessica Mabry. She dies.

(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #14)

June 20 – Jake Weisenfeld dies in a plane crash after the power onboard the plane goes out.

(Timewalker #3)

Shadowman #29 – “If This Be Madness”

June 20 – Shadowman becomes empowered by the sudden flow of necromantic energy. He decides to attack Darque again, who has also been empowered. Darque raises a zombie army to fight against Shadowman. He also raises his old mentor Anton Quigley from the dead to lead the army. Maxim St. James awakens from his coma.

June 20 – After the sudden flow of necromantic energy, Hwen becomes solid again.

(The Second Life of Dr. Mirage #11)

Bloodshot #20 – “Lights Out!”

June 20 – After the sudden flow of necromantic energy Bloodshot’s nanites stop working. The Immortal Enemy gains the ability to switch bodies without having to kill his host. Bloodshot and the Immortal Enemy meet and fight. The Immortal Enemy escapes and heads to the Tower of London where he is compelled to find a silver basin that holds necromantic energy. Bloodshot follows.

Secret Weapons #13 – “Clothes Make the Man”

June 20 – After the sudden flow of necromantic energy the Secret Weapon’s suits stop working. The team goes to the Tower of London to handle a hostage situation. Crona, a being of necromantic energy, is brought back to life by the hostage takers using a silver basin in the Tower. With the help of Bloodshot, the Secret Weapons team is able to send him back to his realm. The Immortal Enemy disappears. Sonar accuses Sinclair of killing the first Para-Man.

Ninjak #8 – “Heart’s Desire”

June 20 – After the sudden flow of necromantic energy Ninjak encounters Mademoiselle Noir. He is able to resist her feminine charms and she becomes intrigued with him. She promises to fulfill his greatest desire, the death of Dr. Silk, in exchange for his love. When faced with Dr. Silk, Ninjak is unable to kill him. Silk escapes and Noir is left alone.

Eternal Warrior #25 – “Risen from the Dead”

June 20 – After the sudden flow of necromantic energy Malloch, an ancient enemy of Gilad’s is brought back to life. Gilad finds him and kills him again.

Archer & Armstrong #25 – “Fossil Fuel”

June 20 – Archer, Armstrong and Geoff are brought to Ladakh by Sandria Darque. There they discover Ivar, the Timewalker, unconscious.

Harbinger #34 – “The Gathering, Part 1 – A Call to Arms”

June 20 – After the sudden flow of necromantic energy Dr. Eclipse abandons his battle with the Harbinger B-Squad. Above Earth the Armorines, the H.A.R.D. Corps and Aric battle Spider Aliens. Toyo Harada, who is aware of the Spider Alien fleet above Earth, forces his way into Sam Kim’s mind.

Armorines #5 – “The Gathering, Part 2 – Search and Destroy”

June 20 – The Armorines and the H.A.R.D. Corps launch into space to fight against the Spider Alien fleet gathering above Earth. They barely escape the sudden flow of necromantic energy that engulfs Earth. Once in space, they begin to battle the Spider Alien fleet. Siroit separates himself from the rest of the Armorines and turns off his communication.

X-O Manowar #33 – “The Gathering, Part 3 – Old Acquaintances”

June 20 – Aric joins the fight against the Spider Alien fleet above Earth. Paul’s consciousness appears to have survived the joining with Pol-Bekhara, and he can communicate with Aric. Aric kills Aristedes. Aric discovers Siroit, one of the Armorines attempting to download information from the Spider Aliens and he stops him. On Earth another member of the Wolfbridge Group is murdered.

Solar, Man of the Atom #38 – “A Distant Call”

June 20 – After the sudden flow of necromantic energy Solar begins to lose control of his abilities. Sandria Darque brings him to Ladakh where he meets up with Archer, Armstrong and Geoff McHenry. Geoff and Solar realize that they need to contact the Destroyer, whose powers will have been unaffected by the Chaos Effect.

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #16 – “The Snake Man”

June 20 – After the sudden flow of necromantic energy the Snakehandler, an old enemy of Turok’s, rises from the dead. He and Turok fight.

(Editor’s Note: At the beginning of the story Turok says he’s been meditating for several days, but this can’t be true because of Turok #17.)

The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #11 – “The One”

June 20 – Sandria Darque finds Hwen Mirage and transports him, Carmen and Shadowman to Ladakh. There Hwen enters the portal where necromantic energy is flowing into the world in attempt to stop it.

(The Second Life of Dr. Mirage #11)

Secrets of the Valiant Universe #2 – “The Darque Gods”

June 21 – Master Darque creates a duplicate Shadowman, and the duplicate goes to Ladakh with Hwen Carmen and Sandria. Maxim St. James sucks Master Darque into his chest tattoo.

June 20 – Agannon, the leader of the Skammrs in Peru becomes empowered by the sudden flow of necromantic energy.

(X-O Manowar #34)

June 21 – The Deathsmith is created, a necromantic being that can shape dead flesh into whatever he wants. He kills 24 people at a gallery opening in Chelsea.

(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #16)

June 21 – The Harbinger loses control of his powers during the Chaos Effect.

(Harbinger Files #2)

June 21 – Thornton Manor in Rhode Island is affected by the Chaos Effect. The current residents are killed by a necromantic entity.

(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #14)

H.A.R.D. Corps #23 – “The Gathering, Part 4 – Unholy Alliance”

June 21 – The H.A.R.D. Corps’ and the Armorines decide to team-up with Harada, who has taken over Sam Kim’s body. With his help they are able to destroy the rest of the Spider Alien fleet.

The Chaos Effect Omega – “From Chaos Comes... Order”

June 21 – Magnus arrives in Ladakh from the year 4020 with a piece of the Destroyer’s power. The Immortal Enemy and Madame Noir try to stop Solar from regaining his power but they are stopped by Dr. Mirage. Solar reconstitutes himself and creates a time portal sending the chaos energies to the beginning of time. The fake Shadowman captures Archer, Armstrong and Geoff and brings them into Solar’s time portal.

June 21 – The Immortal Enemy survives by taking over the body of a monk in Ladakh.

(Eternal Warrior #29)

June 22 – Magnus and Ivar discuss time travel. Ivar jumps through a time portal after their conversation. Chan witnesses their conversation and writes about it in his journal.

(The Chaos Effect Omega)(The Chaos Effect Epilogue)

The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #12 – “Size Matters”

June 22 – Hwen Mirage, Carmen Ruiz and Sandria Darque discuss the events of Chaos Effect.

Shadowman #30 – “Aftermath”

June 22 – Anton Quigley’s reanimated corpse survives the Chaos Effect and he becomes more powerful by absorbing other corpses. Jack plays sax on the street with a group of street performers.

June 23 – Jack tries to stop an arsonist but gets run over by the arsonist’s car. Jack discovers that his sax was stolen by one of the street performers, Billy, for drug money. Jack agrees to help Billy. Jack learns the arsonist is Billy’s brother and Jack kills him.

Armorines #6 – “Unwelcome Visitors”

June 23 – The Armorines and Aric prepare to leave Earth’s orbit when they discover one more Spider Alien vessel, the Spider Alien mothership. The Armorines and Aric begin attacking the vessel.

Armorines #7 – “Sacrifices”

June 23 – The Armorines and Aric successfully destroy the Spider Alien mothership.

June 23 – Hwen Mirage, Carmen Ruiz and Sandria Darque travel back to America.

(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #12)

The Chaos Effect Epilogue – “In Search of Faith, Part 1”

June 23 – In a search for his parents, Magnus breaks into the Harbinger Foundation Facility in New York and learns the Foundation is searching for Faith Herbert. He decides to look for her too.

Harbinger #35 – “No Tomorrow, Part 1 – No Place Like Home”

June 23 – Faith is captured by a group of Eggbreakers and brought to a Harbinger Facility that is a space shuttle launch site. Harada plans to launch a group of Harbingers into space in suspended animation to set up Harbinger colonies. Faith learns that her mother works for Harada on this project and that her birth was arranged by the Foundation. Faith’s new friend Jack and his Uncle attempt to rescue Faith.

Harbinger #36 – “No Tomorrow, Part 2 – Futureshock”

June 24 – Eggbreakers kill Jack’s Uncle. Faith and Jack escape with the help of Magnus. Magnus tells Faith that she becomes the leader of the Harbinger Resistance.

June 24 – Hwen Mirage attempts to make himself solid again but instead shrinks himself. On a second try he is able to hold a solid form, but it only can last for a few hours.

(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #12)

Eternal Warrior #27 – “The Search”

June 24 – Gilad arrives in Ladakh and learns that his brother Armstrong and Geoff McHenry are gone. He begins the search for the next Geomancer.

June 25 – Gilad recovers the Book of Geomancers from Egypt.

June 25 – Jack and Faith make love. Toyo Harada finds Faith.

(Harbinger #36)

Harbinger #37 – “No Tomorrow, Part 3 – The Truth”

June 25 – Harada recaptures Faith and informs her that she’s going to be launched into space on the colony ship. Magnus helps rescue Jack from Harada’s soldiers. Faith organizes the other harbingers being sent on the space mission to resist. With their help she blows up the space shuttle. She and Jack disappear.

June 25 – Magnus goes to Shreveport, Louisiana to look for his father’s grave. When he get there he is attacked by a group of Eggbreakers.

(The Chaos Effect Epilogue)

The Chaos Effect Epilogue – “In Search of Faith, Part 2”

June 25 – Magnus fights off the group of Eggbreakers. He begins to search for his mother.

June 26 – Magnus gets into a fight with another group of Eggbreakers and defeats them.

June 26 – Gilad interviews Geoff McHenry’s parents in his quest to find the next Geomancer.

(Eternal Warrior #27)

June 27 – Gilad tests Elyot Zorn to see if he could be the next Geomancer. The Earth rejects him. Zorn tries to steal the book from Gilad, but fails.

(Eternal Warrior#27)

June 28 – Gilad sets out in search of Clay McHenry to find out if he’s the next Geomancer.

(Eternal Warrior #27)

Harbinger Files #2 – “Metamorphosis”

June 28 – Toyo Harada visits The Harbinger at the Harbinger Foundation facility in Bolivar, Missouri.

June 29 – The Harbinger takes part in a training exercise to test his loyalty. The Harbinger kills a renegade Harbinger. He is given more orders from Harada on another man to kill.

June 30 – The Harbinger carries out the assassination of a former Harbinger Foundation employee.

June 30 – Magnus arrives in Upper St. Clair, Pennsylvania and observes his grandfather's morning routine.
(The Chaos Effect Epilogue)

July 1 – Magnus meets his grandfather in Upper St. Clair, Pennsylvania. Magnus decides to abandon his search for his mother, realizing that she's hiding for a reason.
(The Chaos Effect Epilogue)

Ninjak #9 – “Dogs of War”

July – Mekurakan, a member of the Japanese Yakuza, travels to London to kill Japanese negotiators. In the killings he uses his dogs. Ninjak kills him.

July 7 – Toyo Harada discusses the progress of The Harbinger with Sakai.
(Harbinger Files #2)

Secret Weapons #14 – “Quitting Time”

July – The Secret Weapons team begins to realize that their suits are not working properly. Sonar tries to quit the team but Neville won't let her. The Secret Weapons team attempts to capture the previous owners of the suits in order to diagnose their malfunctions, but the mission fails.

Armorines #8 – “Retrieval”

July – The Armorines participate in a National Security Administration operation to retrieve Dr. Dale Betterton from Iraq.
(Editor's Note: Date is based on subsequent issues.)

Geomancer #1 – “Awakenings”

July – Gilad finds Clay McHenry and hands him the Book of Geomancers. Clay has the sight but Gilad is concerned about his character. McHenry becomes severely wounded after a fight with a group of zombies that are after the Book of Geomancers. Gilad buries McHenry alive in hopes that the Earth will regenerate him.

Geomancer #2 – “Resuscitation”

July – Clay McHenry is successfully regenerated by the Earth and Gilad is satisfied that he is the new Geomancer. Gilad prepares to walk the Earth with McHenry but McHenry claims that he is to walk alone. The Earth gives Gilad a sign that this is true and they go their separate ways.

August – Maxim St. James disappears to the bayou. Darque, who is trapped in James' body, attempts to come back to life. James begins to age quickly.
(Shadowman #42)

X-O Manowar #34 – “The Vengeance Trail, Part 1 – Quest”

August – Aric returns to South America searching for Reece, the man who killed several groups of Yanomama Indians. Aric runs into Skammrs, the group he led in the Lost Land. They take him to their new leader, Agannon.

X-O Manowar #35 – “The Vengeance Trail, Part 2 – Deceitful Players”

August – Agannon drugs Aric and throws him in a pit to fight a Bionisaur without his armor or a way to communicate with it. Randy travels to East Berlin, Germany to find Snakebite, the man who's been killing her former teammates. She learns that there is a traitor in her group.

X-O Manowar #36 – “The Vengeance Trail, Part 3 – Chasing Dreams”

August – Aric recovers his ring with Ken’s help and defeats the Bionisaur and Agannon. Aric learns that Reece, the man he’s been searching for is dead. Randy kills Snakebite and the traitor in her group. She learns that Wolfbridge is behind the attacks. Reece, who faked his death reports in to Mr. Freedman, a man who wishes to reacquire Orb Industries.

Ninjak #10 – “The Little Cossack”

August – Ninjak is sent to Kazakhstan to obtain a new weapon that can destroy flesh but not damage metal. Ninjak destroys the weapon and kills General Vukelic, also known as the Little Cossack.

H.A.R.D. Corps #24 – “Ironhead, Ironheart”

August – The H.A.R.D. Corps recruits a new member, Eddie Abdul, after he enters a coma caused from brain trauma sustained during boxing match. Eddie’s training is unsuccessful and he’s returned to his coma.

Shadowman #31 – “Hunger”

August – Jack gets his sax back. The reanimated corpse of Anton Quigley fights and then absorbs Shadowman. Sandria Darque begins testing her new powers.

Shadowman #32 – “In the Belly of the Beast”

August – Jack Boniface attempts to escape from the reanimated corpse of Anton Quigley. Outside Quigley’s body Sandria Darque assists Jack.

Shadowman #33 – “Quest”

August – Shadowman escapes from inside the reanimated corpse of Anton Quigley, as does Baron Zastrow, also known as John the Conqueror. With the Baron’s help Shadowman defeats Quigley. Nettie travels to Ebner Island where her voodoo altar circle is from. Drug lords have taken over the island. Shadowman and the Baron travel to Ebner Island to help Nettie.

Shadowman #34 – “Song for the Dead”

August 15 – Shadowman and the Baron rescue Nettie and the other residents of Ebner Island. While he does it Shadowman writes lyrics for a new song.

(Editor’s Note: The date says November 15th but it’s clear that the last 5 issues take place very close to each other. To keep the spirit of the date I kept the 15th. It is possible that Jack’s song was written in November.)

August 16 – Shadowman and Nettie leave Ebner Island.

The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #13 – “Soap Stars”

August – While in New York Hwen and Carmen reconnect with their friend Walt Willey, the soap opera actor. Walt is being pursued by a Celtic cult that believes his death at the perfect planetary alignment will lift an ancient curse. Mirage helps Willey escape the cult.

Ninjak Yearbook #1

August – Dr. Silk develops a neutron bomb that has the ability to kill organic matter only. Silk plans to have a bomb go off at the Goodwill Games in Sydney, Australia. Ninjak stops the bomb from exploding in Sydney and kills Harry the Hyena, the man who was planting the bomb. Ninjak travels to Kyushu to discover where Silk is manufacturing the bombs. There Ninjak fights Goro Sanada, the Seventh Dragon. Ninjak destroys Silk’s installation. Silk escapes.

Solar, Man of the Atom #39 – “The Devil in the God”

August – Solar flares cause Solar to have erratic behavior and blackouts. During his blackouts the Sun God personality manifests and destroys nuclear power plants and submarines.

Solar, Man of the Atom #40 – “From A World Away”

August – Using the technology that Phil Seleski has been developing at work. Gayle and Bruce are able to help Seleski purge the Sun God personality.

X-O Manowar #½ - “Chance Encounter”

August - Aric learns of a breakout at a Harbinger prison. He goes to prevent the inmates, Rage, Empath and Field from escaping. Snakebite is responsible for breaking them out. Aric fails and the inmates escape.

X-O Manowar #37 – “The Wolfbridge Affair, Part 1 – ‘Opening Gambit’”

August – Paul’s consciousness takes control of the XO armor and finds Randy in Canada. He transfers himself onto her and tries to convince her to help him gain control of the armor. She refuses and he fades away. Snakebite attacks the armorless Aric.

X-O Manowar #38 – “The Wolfbridge Affair, Part 2 – ‘Pawns’”

August – Randy rescues Aric from Snakebite. Snakebite escapes but Aric puts a tracer on him. Randy and Aric track him to Germany and are confronted by the escaped Harbinger inmates.

X-O Manowar #39 – “The Wolfbridge Affair, Part 3 – Knight Moves”

August – Randy is captured by the Harbinger inmates and is brought to Helena Wolfbridge, the daughter of Kyle Wolfbridge. Aric runs into Ninjak, who is also on Helena’s trail. Helena has stolen nuclear weapons and launches one at Pitcarin Island. Aric stops the nuclear weapon from destroying Pitcarin Island but is caught in the nuclear explosion.

X-O Manowar #40 – “The Wolfbridge Affair, Part 4 – Checkmate”

August – Helena kills June. Aric, poisoned by the radiation, returns to Germany and helps free Ninjak and Randy. Ninjak calls Neville for backup. Aric takes on the Harbinger inmates and defeats them. Randy goes after Helena and kills her but spares Snakebite’s life. Aric flies off still affected by the radiation.

X-O Manowar #41 – “Aftermath”

August – Aric, still affected by the fallout from the nuclear blast, fights off a group of Neo-Nazis. Ninjak helps Randy locate Aric.

August 19 - Gunny’s daughter flies back to New York.

(Conjecture: Gunny says she left “a few days ago.”)(Armorines #9)

The Clinton Administration begins talks with Cuba regarding the preferential treatment given to Cuban refugees.

(Armorines #10)

Armorines #9 – “Private Wars”

August 22 – Siroit goes on a covert mission in Mexico and discovers Arturo Vasquez is making weapons for the cartel leader Javier Cortez. Senator Ackerman’s plans to oust Gunny from the Armorines fail when President Clinton signs an executive order keeping him on the team.

(Conjecture: Issue #10 refers to these events having taken place “a few days ago.”)

Armorines #10 – “The Cuban Connection, Part 1 – Maneuvers”

August 23 – The Armorines team conducts training exercises in Colorado.

August 24 – The Armorines team goes to Miami, Florida to await new orders. They visit the home of Antonio Cordova’s mother.

August 25 – The Armorines are ordered to go to Cuba and apprehend Eduardo Colon, a guerrilla who purchased weapons from Vasquez and Cortez and plans to take over Cuba.

August 26 – The Armorines team makes landfall in Cuba.

(Editor's Note: The caption refers to this being a Thursday, but the 26th was a Friday in 1994.)

Armorines #11 – “The Cuban Connection, Part 2 – Crossfire”

August 26 – The Armorines get caught between Eduardo Colon’s and Fidel Castro’s forces. They manage to kill Colon and rescue Castro. Cordova destroys Castro’s weapons cache.

Secret Weapons #15 – “Intended Weapons”

August – The Secret Weapons team once again attempts to track down the original owners of their suits to solve their glitches. Tank and Para-Man are caught in an explosion. Mach is left catatonic after he defeats Redline. Jillian is kidnapped by Webnet.

Secret Weapons #16 – “Hard Feelings”

September – Neville asks Ninjak for help finding his daughter but he refuses for fear that it would compromise his operations against Webnet. The Secret Weapons team forcefully request Ninjak’s assistance in finding Jillian. Ninjak tells them that Webnet is keeping her in Rome, Italy.

Secret Weapons #17 – “When in Rome”

September – The Secret Weapons team locates Jillian. Sonar considers turning her back over to Webnet at one opportunity. Before they can escape the Secret Weapons face off against Gigo, a genetic experiment who works for Webnet.

Secret Weapons #18 – “Bully”

September – Tank defeats Gigo. With the help of Ninjak the Secret Weapons team escapes from the Webnet facility.

September – Matt, a Los Angeles gang member has what he describes as an extraterrestrial encounter.

(The Visitor #4)

Geomancer #3 – “Challenge”

September – Clay McHenry fights against and defeats the Elemental creatures Master Darque created. McHenry finds a green cloak and silver cane. McHenry’s cousin Elyot Zorn requests McHenry’s presence.

Geomancer #4 – “Ties That Bind”

September – Elyot Zorn tries to steal the Book of Geomancers from Clay McHenry, but fails.

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #17 – “Jurassic Politics, Part 1 – The Domino Theory”

September 17 – A group of Israeli spies is killed by Bionisaur. A South African spy is also killed by a Bionisaur.

September 18 – The CIA asks Turok for help in discovering why Bionisaur are attacking foreign government’s spies on US soil. Turok agrees to assist in the hunt for the Bionisaur.

September 19 – The team that the CIA puts together to help Turok’s hunt is wiped out in a Bionisaur attack.

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #18 – “Jurassic Politics, Part 2 – White Man Speak with Forked Tongue”

September 19 – Turok tracks the Bionisaur to Utah and discovers that Spider Aliens have been controlling them. Turok calls Aric and tells him that if he hasn’t heard from him in 24 hours to come looking for him. Turok discovers that the Spider Aliens are being led by Hidgeon, a member of the CIA, who helped put the hunting party together for Turok earlier. The Spider Aliens capture Turok.

September 20 – After the 24 hours are up with no word from Turok, Aric travels to Utah.

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #19 – “Jurassic Politics, Part 3 – The Price of Vengeance”

September 20 – With the help of Aric, Turok destroys the Spider Alien facility and Hidgeon is killed.

The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #14 – “Unfinished Business, Part 1”

September 21 – Hwen and Carmen learn of Thornton Manor in Rhode Island.

September 22 – Hwen and Carmen meet Professor Mabry at Thornton Manor and begin investigating the property. Carmen is attacked by a necromantic entity. The Professor’s assistant, Chris, is also attacked by the entity. When Doctor Mirage confronts it, it begins to drain his energy.

The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #15 – “Unfinished Business, Part 2”

September 22 – The necromantic entity flees. Hwen revives Chris.

September 23 – Doctor Mirage, Carmen and Professor Mabry return to Thornton Manor and destroy it, killing the necromantic entity, which is the manifestation of Jeremiah Thornton’s hate.

September 24 – President Bill Clinton is briefed about the recent Bionisaur raids.

(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #19)

September - Aric fully recovers from his radiation poisoning.

(X-O Manowar #41)

September 26 – Hwen and Carmen visit Chris in the hospital.

(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #15)

Late September – The Secret Weapons team and Jillian Alcott recover from their injuries. Sonar and Jillian fight each other to clear the air between them. Ninjak requests Mach’s presences on a mission.

(Conjecture: Even though no caption says it, these events seem to take place separately from the beginning of the issue.)(Secret Weapons #18)

H.A.R.D. Corps #25 – “Bring Me the Head of Earl Simkus”

September – Heydrich gains Toyo Harada’s powers. He orders the H.A.R.D. Corps to capture and terminate Earl Simkus.

H.A.R.D. Corps #26 – “That’s Earl, Brother”

September – Earl proves to the members of H.A.R.D. Corps that their comas were caused on purpose so they could be recruited by Heydrich. They quit Hard C.O.R.P.S. and become renegades. Heydrich sends Grasshopper, a new recruit, to kill one of Omen Enterprises board members. Heydich gathers his rookie H.A.R.D. Corps members to counteract the renegades.

H.A.R.D. Corps #27 – “Generation Gap, Part 1”

October – The renegades and rookies battle in Canada. Earl finds a way to suppress the brain pop. He also suggests that the renegades steal a Canadian stealth plane. Heydrich finds Virgil Peeves’ son in Ho Chi Minh City. He agrees to help Heydrich kill his father.

October – Ninjak and Mach arrive in New Orleans.

(Secret Weapons #18)

Secret Weapons #19 – “Bayou Nights”

October – After helping Ninjak complete a mission in New Orleans, Mach goes on a personal vendetta, seeking revenge for the injuries he sustained against Redline. Mach kills Redline.

H.A.R.D. Corps #28 – “Payback”

October – The Hard C.O.R.P.S. renegades seek asylum in the newly democratic country of Kazakhstan. The rookies attack, including Payback, the son of Virgil Peeves.

H.A.R.D. Corps #29 – “Bad Son Rising”

October – Earl is able to block the rookies Harbinger powers and the group retreats. Heydrich kills Softcore. The renegades discover that Heydrich and his team of rookies are hiding on an aircraft carrier in the Indian Ocean and attack.

H.A.R.D. Corps #30 – “Over the Top”

October – The renegades are able to defeat Heydrich and with the help of Toyo Harada’s mental powers Heydrich is killed.

October – Bored with his inability to die, Solar creates a dual identity, Phil Miller, a cop who works in Las Vegas. He also begins seeing another woman, Brenda.

(Conjecture: Phil says he’s been doing this for “a few months.”)(Solar, Man of the Atom #44) (Solar, Man of the Atom #45)

The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #16 – “Building the Perfect Beast, Part 1”

October 10 – The Deathsmith kills forty people on a subway in New York City.

October 13 – Hwen and Carmen investigate the subway murders.

October 14 – Hwen and Carmen go out to dinner with Carmen’s parents. The Deathsmith arrives at the restaurant.

The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #17 – “Building the Perfect Beast, Part 2”

October 14 – Hwen is unable to change into his phantom form. He and Carmen are chased throughout the Metropolitan Museum of Art by the Deathsmith.

The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #18 – “Building the Perfect Beast, Part 3”

October 14 – Hwen regains his powers and defeats the Deathsmith.

October 17 – Carmen sees her parents off at the airport.

(Conjecture: The caption says “a few days later.”)

Bloodshot #21 – “The More Things Change...”

October – Ax attacks Bloodshot with a remote controlled robot. Bloodshot destroys the robot. The Immortal Enemy returns to New York City. He ousts Carboni as the number one mobster in town and assembles a group of bounty hunters to capture Bloodshot.

(Editor’s Note: Date comes from comment in Bloodshot #23 by Cinder.)

October – A badly burnt Ax is found by British Intelligence and brought to London. He is imprisoned in a cell with no electricity.

(Secret Weapons #20)

Bloodshot #22 – “Wanted: Dead or Alive!”

October – Bloodshot fights off a group of bounty hunters sent to kill him. Laws, one of the bounty hunters, succeeds in knocking Bloodshot unconscious.

Bloodshot #23 – “A Touch of Fire”

October – Bloodshot escapes from Laws. Cinder recovers his harbinger ability to create fire and attacks Bloodshot. A Black Ops Harbinger squad that has Glyder on it assists Bloodshot in defeating Cinder. The Black Ops group brings Cinder to the Harbinger Foundation.

Bloodshot #24 – “The Blind Leading the Blind”

October – With the help of Clay McHenry, the Geomancer, Bloodshot defeats the bounty hunters sent to kill him by the Immortal Enemy. The Immortal Enemy escapes from Bloodshot.

Geomancer #5 – “Riot Gear, Part 1 – Sacrifice”

October – The officers who set Clay McHenry and his partner up to take the fall learn that McHenry is back in New York City. Clay goes to the hospital to protect his former partner. Turok and Andy visit New York City.

Geomancer #6 – “Riot Gear, Part 2 – Revenge”

October – With the help of Turok, Clay McHenry is able to expose the police officers in the NYPD who are on the mob’s take.

October – Elyot Zorn becomes empowered by the green cloak that Clay had found in Egypt and left at Zorn’s place in France. The cloak begins to change his appearance and he refuses to leave his room.

(Geomancer #7)

Eternal Warrior #28 – “The Immortal War, Part 1 – Adrift”

October – With the help of Lt. Morgan, Gilad busts up a crack house in New York City. The crack house is run by the Immortal Enemy’s new criminal operations.

Eternal Warrior #29 – “The Immortal War, Part 2 – Burden of Knowing”

October – Morgan tries to put a halt to Gilad’s vigilantism. Gilad confronts the Immortal Enemy and is overwhelmed by his forces. Gilad falls out a window of a high rise.

Eternal Warrior #30 – “The Immortal War, Part 3 – A Friend in Need”

October – Gilad lands on Morgan’s car. The two are chased by the Immortal Enemy’s men. After a car chase and a shoot-out in a cemetery Morgan and Gilad escape the Immortal Enemy’s men.

Eternal Warrior #31 – “The Immortal War, Part 4 – The Last Trap”

October – Gilad tracks down the Immortal Enemy and attacks him. He plucks out his eyes so he can’t transfer from one body to another and leaves him in a frozen wasteland.

Geomancer #7 – “Desert Storm”

October – After travelling to New Mexico with Turok, Clay heads to Las Vegas. Elyot Zorn also goes to Vegas to reclaim Samantha, Clay’s ex-wife.

Geomancer #8 – “And in the End...”

October – Elyot Zorn and Clay McHenry battle. Clay defeats his cousin and is reunited with Samantha.

October – Randy tells Aric that their relationship can no longer be anything other than friendship.

(X-O Manowar #41)

October 27 – The Harbinger Foundation successfully launches a colony ship filled with harbingers.

(Conjecture: Harada said the ship “left Earth weeks ago.”)(Solar, Man of the Atom #41)

Ninjak #13 – “Mad Dog and Englishmen”

November – Ninjak goes into war torn Yemen and rescues Robert Folly, a British agent.

The Visitor vs. the Valiant Universe #1 – “Stranger in a Strange Land, Part 1”

November 9 – A new hero called the Visitor appears in Los Angeles. Toyo Harada encourages a local news outlet to question the Visitor’s motives.

November 11 – Harada’s misinformation campaign about the Visitor takes full effect.

November 14 – Aric, the Armorines, Bloodshot and the Secret Weapons all prepare to confront the Visitor.
(Conjecture: The caption says “in the following days.”)

November 15 – Aric attacks the Visitor believing the reports about him are true. The Visitor offers no defense and Aric takes his silence for guilt. Solar and the Armorines join the fight.

The Visitor vs. the Valiant Universe #2 – “Stranger in a Strange Land, Part 2”

November 15 – Bloodshot and the Secret Weapons join the fight against the Visitor. The Visitor finally breaks his silence and the large battle ceases.

Solar, Man of the Atom #41 – “Farewell”

November 17 – Harada’s second colony ship malfunctions. He recruits Solar to help repair it. Solar rescues a young harbinger named Photon and brings him back to Earth.

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #20 – “Nest of Snakes”

November – Chichak, the leader of the Spider People escapes from prison and returns to the New River Gorge. Turok pursues him. Bounty hunters, including the Longhunter, also search for Chichak. Longhunter attacks Turok.

(Editor’s Note: Story is laced in November because of Geomancer #5-7.)

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #21 – “Mystery Hole”

November – Turok is rescued by two bounty hunters, the Dillard Brothers. Turok teams up with the brothers and heads to where Chichak and the man who helped break him out of jail, Ripsaw, are hiding out. As they try to infiltrate Ripsaw’s camp they are discovered.

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #22 – “Rampage on New River”

November – Turok, Regan and the Dillard Brothers are captured by Ripsaw. Ripsaw betrays Chichak and makes him his prisoner. Ripsaw forces Chichak and Turok to fight each other.

Turok Dinosaur Hunter #23 – “Mystery Wheel”

November – Turok and Chichak fight but soon realize they should fight together. The Longhunter reappears. Turok and Regan have an argument. Turok, Andy and Chichak flee into the woods. They find a portal that returns them to the Lost Land.

Armorines #12 – “The Ties that Bind”

November – Senator Ackerman acquires a tape from Peter Garret showing the Armorines on their Cuban mission destroying Cuban weapons. Ackerman uses the tape to force Gunny to quit the Armorines. Siroit kills Peter Garrett.

(Conjecture: After the Visitor vs. the Valiant Universe #2.)

Bloodshot #25 – “Big Trouble in Little Clown Town”

November – Bloodshot travels to Florida where he reunites with Uzzi the Clown. Uzzi and his co-worker’s land are being threatened by the mob. Uzzi convinces his fellow carnies to fight back. Bloodshot is drawn into the battle.

Bloodshot #26 – “Uzzi and His Killer Clown Commandos!”

November – Uzzi and Bloodshot fight back the mob.

Harbinger #38 – “Pierced Hearts”

November – The B-Squad has an encounter with Spikeman in New York City.

Harbinger #39 – “Renegades”

November – The B-Squad runs into Faith. She convinces them that Harada is trying to create a master race of Harbingers. They decide to join her in her fight against the Foundation. They break into the Harbinger Foundation in New York to save Mira, but she refuses to go with them. The B-Squad has a run-in with a group of Eggbreakers but escapes.

Eternal Warrior #32 – “A Small Conflict”

December – Gilad meets Migdalia de los Santos and helps her family fend off a neighborhood gang.

(Editor’s Note: A page of this comic was missing when it went to print. The missing page was printed in Eternal Warrior #36.)

The Visitor #1 – “Layers Upon Layers”

December – Toyo Harada sends the Harbinger to California to confront the Visitor.

The Visitor #2 – “Masks”

December – The Visitor defeats the Harbinger after a long battle.

December 8 – Solar helps Photon start a new life apart from the Harbinger Foundation.

(Solar, Man of the Atom #41)

Shadowman #35 – “Cinderella Blues, Part 1”

December – Marcia Lewis witnesses Bobby Genoa kill a man. Bobby hires Ishmael to kill her and witnesses to his other crimes. Jack helps Marcia get into protective custody. Shadowman and Ishmael square off.

Shadowman #36 – “Cinderella Blues, Part 2 – Flames of Rage”

December – Shadowman’s and Ishmael’s fight is broken up by gunfire. Ishmael learns where Marcia is being held. He kidnaps her and calls Shadowman to come get her. Shadowman defeats Ishmael and rescues Marcia.

Solar, Man of the Atom #42 – “The Elements of Evil, Part 1”

December – Phil, Gayle, Bruce and Karry vacation in Hawaii. Terrance and Abdul create a new elemental, Kris, who has the ability to manipulate air currents. They attack Solar in Hawaii. Lani, a friend of Gayles, is kidnapped by the elementals.

Solar, Man of the Atom #43 – “The Elements of Evil, Part 2”

December – The elementals give Lani the ability to manipulate fire. She attacks Solar. Solar is able to remind her of who she is and the two attack and defeat the elementals. Lani forgets what happened to her.

December – Jason Haynes, a lawyer for one of Colin King’s corporate holdings, goes missing off the coast of South America.
